## **ANBI POLICY PLAN – STICHTING TOGETHER FOR GIRLS NETHERLANDS**

### NOTE ON GOVERNANCE AND ANBI PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The initial board meeting of Stichting Together for Girls Netherlands has taken place, on January 29, 2026, and the following decisions were formally adopted:

1. Governance and executive model:  
One of the board members has been hired as a consultant for a period of six months to support the establishment of the foundation. In this time-bound role, the board member holds defined executive responsibilities related to set-up and initial operations. This arrangement has been approved by the board and is structured to remain compliant with ANBI regulations.

#### I. Introduction

Stichting Together for Girls Netherlands is an independent Dutch foundation established to mobilize resources, partnerships, and influence in Europe in support of the global mission to end sexual violence against children and adolescents.

The foundation operates in close alignment with the global Together for Girls partnership and its 2024–2030 Strategy, which sets out a shared vision, strategic objectives, and interconnected initiatives to advance prevention, healing, and justice for children and adolescents worldwide. While Stichting Together for Girls Netherlands is legally and financially independent from Together for Girls (US), the organizations share a common mission, values, and strategic



direction. Collaboration takes place on the basis of complementary roles, shared objectives, and respect for independent governance and decision-making.

## II. Objective and policy

The foundation aims to prevent and end sexual violence against children and adolescents, particularly girls, in full alignment with the mission and global strategy of Together for Girls.

Stichting Together for Girls Netherlands contributes to advancing the overall Together for Girls strategy by mobilizing European funding, partnerships, and engagement in support of global and country-led efforts to:

- Increase political will and public awareness to address sexual violence against children and adolescents.
- Strengthen prevention, healing, and justice responses through evidence-based, survivor-centered approaches.
- Support the use of data, advocacy, and coordinated action to drive sustainable change.

The foundation is legally independent and programmatically aligned with Together for Girls (US). Any collaboration or financial support is provided in a manner consistent with ANBI regulations and exclusively in pursuit of public benefit objectives.

## III. Activities

The activities of Stichting Together for Girls Netherlands are designed to support and advance the global Together for Girls strategy and include:

- Mobilizing financial resources in Europe to support Together for Girls' global and country-led work to prevent sexual violence against children and adolescents, with a focus on prevention, healing, and justice.

- Providing financial support to programmes and initiatives that align with the Together for Girls strategic framework, including:
  - Generation and use of data and evidence to inform policy and action.
  - Survivor-centered advocacy and movement-building.
  - Knowledge-sharing on effective solutions to prevent and respond to sexual violence against children and adolescents.
- Contributing to European awareness-raising, policy dialogue, and engagement related to ending sexual violence against children, in coordination with the broader Together for Girls partnership.
- Building and strengthening networks in Europe among governments, foundations, civil society organizations, researchers, and advocates committed to advancing children's safety and well-being.

Activities may be carried out directly by the foundation or indirectly through grants and financial contributions to aligned programmes and partners, in accordance with ANBI requirements and the foundation's public benefit purpose.

#### IV. Board and governance

Board members:

Board members serve on an unpaid basis. Only reimbursement of reasonable expenses is permitted. One exception is Babet Reinders, who will be contracted on a short-term basis to perform executive and operational duties in compliance with ANBI regulations. This was approved by the Board on Jan 29, 2026.

#### V. Funds and expenditure

The foundation's income is derived from donations, grants, foundations, sponsorships, and legacies.

All funds are exclusively applied to activities that serve the public benefit purpose of preventing and ending sexual violence against children and adolescents, in line with this policy plan and applicable ANBI regulations.



The assets will be managed by ABN Amro Bank and held in a special account designated for Together for Girls Netherlands.

## VI. Financial outlook

The year 2026 is anticipated to be the first full operational year of the foundation.

The period 2026–2027 will focus on organizational set-up, positioning within the European philanthropic and policy landscape, and gradual scaling of fundraising and grant-making activities in alignment with the Together for Girls global strategy.
